1. Introduction

Grounds for Termination

Membership may be terminated for violations of these T&Cs, non-payment of fees, or behavior deemed unacceptable by the Club.

Procedure

The Club will notify the member in writing of any termination. Terminated members must return their membership card and will not be entitled to a refund.

9. Amendments

Changes to T&Cs

We reserve the right to amend these T&Cs at any time. Members will be notified of significant changes via email or through our website.

Notification

Changes will take effect 30 days after notification. Continued use of the Club's services constitutes acceptance of the new T&Cs.
